Look to see which of those sales are open on the day you are shopping. Although the event spans three days, sellers' availability varies. Some only selected days. On our list we have noted to the best of our ability the days and hours of each.

For your safety and convenience, please note:

- **Safety:** Park vehicles with *all four wheels* outside the solid white "fog line" seen at the side of the road.
- **Gas:** There is NO GASOLINE sold in Thurman, so please watch your gauge.
- **Phone:** Cell phone service is nonexistent in most parts of town except sometimes at high elevations. There's a land line available just inside the town hall entryway, 311 Athol Rd. Local or calling card calls only.
