Welcome to the Thurman Townwide Sale. As you can see, our yard sale bonanza spans three days. The days and hours of the sale provide general guidelines. Some of our sellers will sell all three days, and others only selected days. Some open early, some a tad late. We have noted to the best of our ability the availability of each on this listing. We hope these pages of information and accompanying map will help you to find all of the sales and conveniences you are looking for all weekend long. Do save the map and calendar of upcoming events so you can come back to enjoy our Monday Night Concerts in the Park, Thurman Woodsmen's Competition, the annual historic house tour, Fall Farm Tour, Country Christmas Bazaar and much more. There's seldom a dull moment in Thurman!

For your safety and convenience, please note:

- **Safety:** The Sheriff's Department has advised us that motorists who park unsafely may be ticketed. To avoid this risk—and, more importantly, to prevent accidents—please make every effort to park with *all four wheels* outside the solid white “fog line” seen at the side of the road.
- **Gas:** There is **NO GASOLINE** sold in Thurman, so please watch your gauge.
- **ATM:** It is *unlikely* that the ATM at the Athol General Store, 113 Mountain Road will be functioning, as the store is closed.
- **Phone:** Cell phone service is nonexistent in most parts of town. If you are desperate, your best luck will be down along the river or at high elevations such as found on Sky Hi Road. There's a land line available just inside the unlocked town hall entryway, 311 Athol Rd. It may be used for local or calling card calls only.
- **Rest rooms** can be found
 - all three days at: 311 Athol Rd., at 564 River Rd. (Glen-Hudson Campsite), and at the Beagle Club on Zaltz Rd.;
 - all three days at 188 Bear Pond Road;
 - Friday, Saturday (and Sunday after church only) at Thurman Baptist Church, 380 S. Johnsbury Rd..
- Our sale is made possible each year by enthusiastic cooperation from many groups and individuals, and it would be impossible to credit them all in this small space.
